

The Township recently acquired seven (7) Automated External Defibrillators (AED's). AED's have been proven to make a difference between life and death when used during Sudden Cardiac Arrest. Five (5) units will be used in Police Patrol Vehicles, one (1) at the Mary Barness Tennis and Swim Club and one (1) at the Public Works Complex.



One of the units was donated jointly by HeartSine of Newtown, the manufacturer of the AED, and CPR Heart Starters, Inc., a Warrington based business that also sells AED's and provides Safety Training. Warrington Township thanks both companies for their generous donations.
