Old Business

A. New trail development

Roy Rieder reported that the title for the Vesci property was received, and the title search came back clean. They were working on finalizing the acquisition of the property. After acquisition, an additional 300-foot section of trail will be constructed towards Phillips Avenue.

Gerry Sapers received a comment from Tony Black, General Manager of Valley Square (Poag, LLC). He wants to put a woods trail near Walnut Avenue off of Street road. Roy Rieder stated that the area off Walnut Avenue is not owned by Poag. Also, they want to complete a trail near the old Borders store to get closer to Kemper Park.

Aaron has three volunteers for the Natural Trail Project, and they are coming from the Bucks County Road Runners. These volunteers will blaze a new route, mark it with flags, and obtain GPS coordinates.

C. EAC
