APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Committee members gave an overview of what the Bike Hike Committee does and what role it plays as an advisory to the Parks & Recreation service. A motion was proposed by Scott to approve Veronica as a committee member. Lynette seconded the motion. Motion was passed and will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

New Trail Development - Andy

Work is progressing at Pickertown & Folly. Pavement poured starting at the Public Works Bldg 202 is moving along nicely. Stump to Public Works. Abutments for the bridge, Millcreek

Proposals - Andy - No new proposals

Warrington day – officially cancelled for Sept. 2020. Will resume Sept. 2021

Fishing Derby status - Motion proposed to cancel for 2020 due to the difficulty to hold during the pandemic. Also following the lead from Warrington Day being cancelled, since the derby is typically in conjunction with Warrington Day. Motion carried.

Birding walk status - also cancelled due to keeping in conjunction with Warrington Day. Motion was proposed and carried. Same as above.

Access path to 202 Bypass – Warrington Lea - Andy.

Needs to be an access path from the 202 bypass to Warrington Glen and over cross street to Folly. Just approved by Board of Supervisors a cross walk from Upper Nike to Lower Nike. A developer bought the Truck Patch parcel. The township got the approval from the new developer

to put in the cross-walk. abutments to connect to Mill Rd.

Warrington Steps Challenge - Sethu initiated

- 4 week challenge with a goal of 10,000 steps.
- Should be sent out by the township, and run through a google account
- Every Sunday the participant would enter their steps on the community website
- Enter the raffle to win a prize
- Need sponsors for gift cards
- Launch in Sept. 2020

Update Warrington trail maps

The trail maps are 10 yrs old and need to be updated. Some of the proposals on the map have never been completed. Trails need rehab. We could use the Scouts to do some of the work. We will need the current copy of the trail map. Proposal was put into motion and passed to get the trail map updated.

Should the committee work on the trail map to update and propose to the supervisors for approval of an updated Trail map. - yes

Eagle scouts

Committee proposed to find projects along the trails that need to be done. We can engage the Eagle Scouts for projects such as planning, design, communication. They would be responsible for finding sponsors, volunteers, making the phone calls, finding supplies needed for the projects.

Committee proposed to do a road trip as a group to walk the trails in Warrington to become familiar with the sites and be better informed. Motion was passed to to schedule two dates in late July or early August to cover the trails.
