COMMITTEE BUSINESS

1. New Trail Development. - Andy

- Official opening for the fence that separates the public works yard at the 202 Bradford Dam & Stump Road will take place the 2nd or 3rd. Week of Oct.
- Q: came from Sethu on any bids for the #611, & Shetland - Freedoms Way ? A: No, nothing. It will be pushed to the Board of Supervisors
- Boardwalk trail next to Lions Pride Park to go into the woods - not started yet.
- Wetland trail will loop around pond - observation deck - both on the plans to develop

- Emerson Farm at Pickertown Rd. (67 acres) - Bike trail is factored in, eventually connecting to existing trails.
- Perry Farm - is open space, so there will be a sidewalk on Street Rd.
- Enclave at Warrington - (Bridge to nowhere) intersects of Wedgeway to #611

5. Update Warrington trail maps.
