INFORM - Item of the Month

- trail speed and etiquette for this month
- Suggested Item on rookeries or herons nesting in the Millcreek area

Ordinance of Motorized Vehicles on Trails:

- Discussion ensued around e-bikes
- Put signs up No motorized vehicles
- Emphasize SPEED and ETIQUETTE
- Erynn researched local townships for what speed limits they had in place. 15 MPH was mainstream.
- Consensus was to make the Speed limit on our trails = 15 MPH
- Speed limit signs to be installed at the entrance of the trails
- Motion from Scott for committee to put the 15 MPH speed limit and signs into place.
 Motion was seconded.
- E-Link article next month to be phrased, "All trails are not the same". Use good judgement on your speed. 15 MPH may not apply where you are riding. Keep in mind pedestrians possibly coming up around a bend that are not within your vision.

NEW TRAIL UPDATES - Andy Oles

- Andy to check with BOS about putting together trail usage on bike speed limits.
- Etiquette rules posting Andy recommends putting a sign at the Special Equestrian location. There's a wooden board with a roof that the rules could be posted.
- Pause on trail construction and maintenance waiting for materials and weather to break looking towards April.
- Equestrian trail needs "trail heads" signage. Sign to be put up to direct to the trails. Property is 1/2 Equestrian 1/2 Trails.
 - Crushed stone to natural grass tree line needs to be enhanced.

- Bradford Green from County Line Rd. trail disconnects there should be a little footpath.
- Due to the recent smash and grab incident at Lion's Pride, possibly an article in the e-Link to remind people not to leave valuables in their cars while parked near the trails. Most importantly in view.
