#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

#### **COMMITTEE BUSINESS**

- Eagle Projects
  - RJ's Eagle project for trail markers from 202 bypass to Bradford dam was discussed.
  - RJ and his dad, Rob Spruhde, attended the meeting.
  - RJ proposed using sign markers instead of routing on the 4x4 posts.
  - The committee and Andy expressed no opposition to using sign markers, and a few suggestions were made, including the use of green and white or federal brown colors.
  - RJ will present the sign design to the committee before finalizing.
  - Andy suggested that the township can assist with digging the holes for the posts, and RJ will mark the locations for the posts.
  - Andy also proposed allowing a vehicle from the township to transport heavy materials to hard-to-reach spots.
  - The signs will be placed in a way that ensures proper visibility from both directions.
- Trail updates
  - The township is adding finishing touches to Segment B, including the installation of a split rail fence at the hard turn on Pickertown Road and Lower state road.
  - Enlarging the radius at Mill Creek and Bellflower will improve safety for cyclists at sharp turns.
  - Plans are underway to make the equestrian trail more accessible to residents.
  - Two grants have been applied for to add a flashing crossing at the Street Road crossing between Morning Walk Dr and Magnolia Dr.
  - Andy is working on the installation of new stop signs at Station 78 crossing into Segment A.
  - The committee recommended a new sign for the circuit trails.
  - Clean-up of the old yard waste is scheduled.

- Andy will work on adding Etiquette signs to the trails.
- Inform item of the month.
  - Suggestions for the item of the month:
    - Hydrate and use the trails in the morning or evening, especially during the hottest month of the year.
    - Responsible pet care on the trails.
- 2023 events
  - Warrington Day:
    - Scott will request literature for the Warrington Day booth.
    - The committee requested a large new map with the latest trail markings from Andy to display at the booth.
    - Scout Troop 133 will assist with the Warrington Day fishing derby.
    - Eryn assisted in filling out the sponsorship request PDF form for Sportsman's Warehouse. Scott will submit the form.

    - Committee members are encouraged to volunteer at the Warrington Tri.
