Pollution in Runoff

Runoff water is polluted with sewage, sediments, paints, chemicals, oil, etc. These pollutants affect the fish in the water. Some contaminants can accumulate in their bodies. These contaminants can potentially be passed on to humans through the food chain.

Disturbance of Waterways

Removal of gravel from streams, building roadways through a stream, changing the stream's flow and draining a waterway are all actions that can cause disturbance to a stream. The resulting damage can kill fish in the water.


