Habitat Protection:

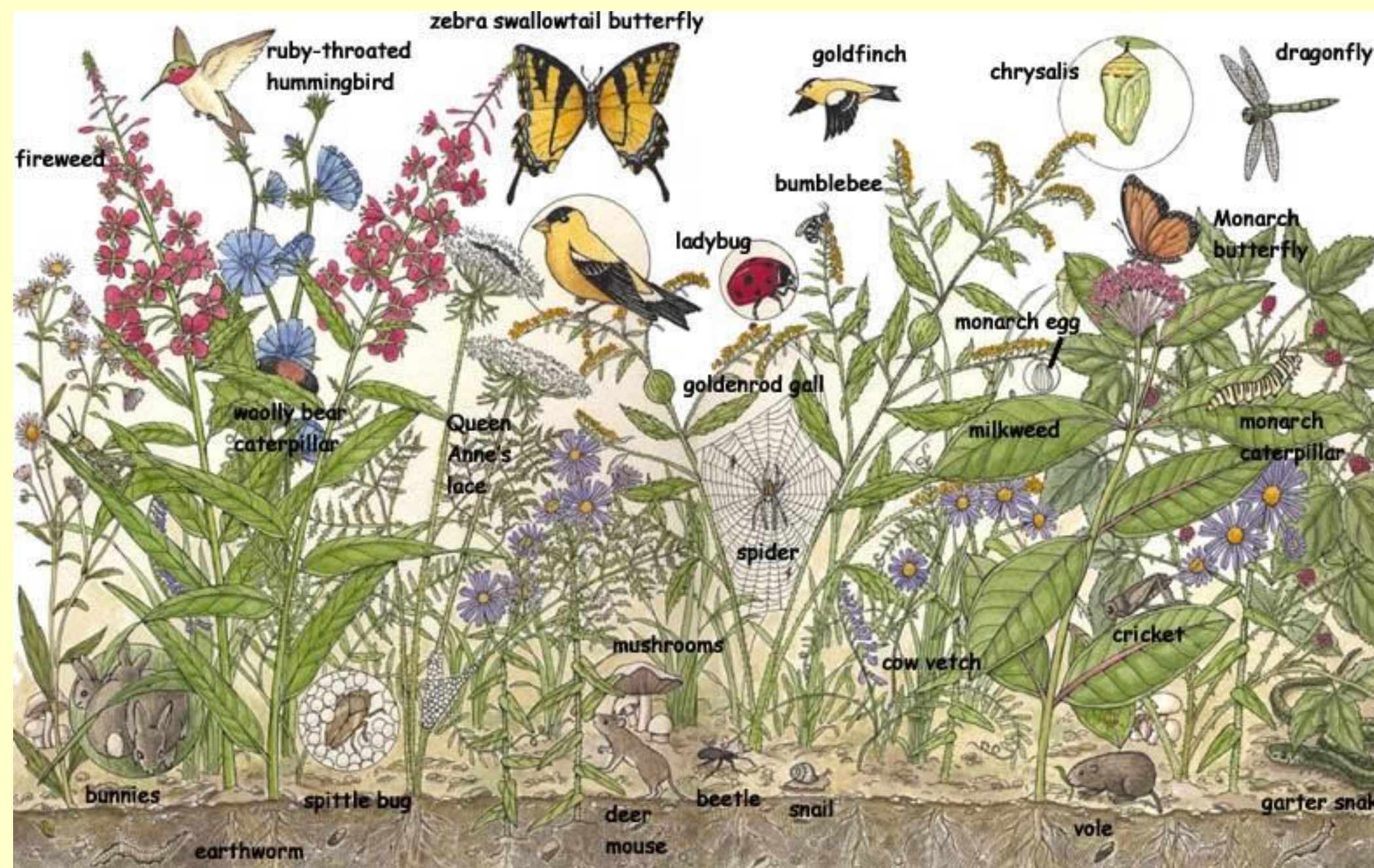
A beautiful variety of plants and flowers become safe home to many wonderful insects, birds, mammals, and invertebrates.
