The Day of Community Service will be held at the old Twin Oaks Day Camp on May 18, 2019 from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The rain date will be Sunday, May 19, 2019.

Activities will include the following:

- Building blue bird, screech owl and bat houses
- Building rain barrels
- Planting shrubs and flowers
- Maintaining a cluster planting project in Lower Nike Park
- Naturalization of a detention basin on Buttercup Boulevard
- Maintaining the naturalized detention basins planted during previous Earth Day/Community Service Day events
- Upkeep of existing rain and butterfly gardens in Igoe Porter Wellings (IPW) Park
- Maintaining our Edible Forest on Morning Walk trail and in Lower Nike Park
- Adopt-A-Road cleanups throughout the township
- Willow Knoll
- Cleanup of the Igoe Porter Wellings (IPW) Park

We would like to invite local businesses and community groups including Girl Scout, Brownie, Daisy and Boy Scout troops and Cub Scout dens. We also welcome members of elementary, secondary and high schools, the Central Bucks South High School Environmental Club, Key Club, CB Cares, and the National Honor Society, to take part.
