Meeting Minutes

- WHC members approved the November 9, 2020 meeting minutes.
  - New Business
    - Commission roster. Chair and Tu have requested BoS to renew their WHC membership.
    - At proper time, WHC will consider Mr. Peranteau's application as a new member.
    - Chair indicated that Township Ordinance limits the number of WHC membership to 7. Long term inactivity of any current member may deprive the opportunity of other Township residents to serve. Mr. Stu Cohen has been an inactive member since his recent 2019-2021 appointment. All attending WHC members unanimously voted for a motion to make one last attempt to contact Mr. Cohen requesting him to formally resign from WHC before the end of 2020.

    - McNaney subdivision at 545 Folly Road. Township formed an ad hoc committee to discuss with McNaney family and developer to explore an acceptable win-win plan for all concerned parties.
    - Kathy reported that she will design an interpretative signage for Nike site.
    - Chair indicated that she has received all needed input to update Warrington Township website "History Tab".

Site planned for the new school sign will not be impacted by the next phase of PennDOT County Line project that is planned for completion by 2027.
