a) Open Space Parcel Discussion and Levels of Protection

Ruth, Ivy, Mike D., and Terry Clemens met. Levels of protection were established. The levels as established are numbered in reverse order to what was presented at the November meeting. i.e, Number One is the highest level of protection.

Level 1

Full easement. \$15,000 one time fee per parcel if held by Heritage Conservancy. Township will handle encroachments. Considered parcels are Emerson Farms, Weisel, Laurel Gardens and Grove Valley combined. Mill Creek is already held by Natural Lands.

Level 2

Blanket easement. Land from developers would be protected.

Level 3

No protection. this would include active parks and fields, most tot lots.

Discussion followed considering levels of protection for various parcels.

b) Memorial Tree Planting Project

Doylestown Township has a program that is an example. Rick Weiss will present the concept to Park and Rec.

c) Master Plan Update

Mill Creek Ad Hoc committee met. At January 12 meeting, members will be updated. All Open Space meeting attendees were unanimous that all committees should have input to the BOS on this.

d) Investigating Conservation Easements

Discussion on how to move forward to acquire more land for Open Space. Conservation easements are one possibility.

f) Recycling in Parks and Open Spaces
