Monument of Daniel P. Bradley:

The VAC met at the Nike Missile monument to review the placement of the Daniel P. Bradley monument and bronze plaque. Their preliminary plan is to have the monument in front of the rock with the missile plaque on it and install the plaque in front of the monument. Public Works will do the installation. The two bushes on the side of the rock will be removed and smaller shrubs planted to replace them.

The write up for the bronze plaque was edited by Chris Patton as follows:

Daniel P. Bradley, Jr. was a U.S. Army Specialist 4 (SP4) stationed at the Warrington Nike Base. He was tragically killed in an accident on July 28, 1958. He had been an avid softball player, and after his death, the Nike Base command named the base softball field in his honor, placing this memorial marker at the field. SP4 Bradley is also the namesake of Bradley Road in Warrington, which runs alongside the former Nike Base where he was memorialized.
