**The Board of Supervisors On the Move** - The Board of Supervisors meeting was moved to the new Department of Public Works complex to showcase the recently completed facility and conduct a formal ribbon cutting. The 13,300 square foot main building will allow for the storage and maintenance of the Township's vehicles and equipment and even includes a wash bay to wash all the salt and debris off the trucks. **Warrington Awarded Grant from PECO** - Ted Dorand from PECO Energy and Diane Rosencrance from the Natural Lands Trust were on hand to present a \$10,000 grant to the Township to defray the costs of installing pedestrian trails in the Township. This was the second \$10,000 grant awarded by PECO. Mr. Dorand thanked the Board for their commitment to preserving open space and providing trails throughout the Township. Chairman Anderson commented that Warrington Township was the first Township in Bucks County to have a voter referendum approved to provide funds to preserve open space.



**Director of Warrington Township Water and Sewer to Retire** – Long time Township employee and resident Fred Achenbach is retiring at the end of the month. Mr. Achenbach is the Director of the Township’s Water and Sewer Department. He has a long history with the Township including stints on the Board of Supervisors, the Planning Commission, and Environmental Advisory Council. Secretary/Treasurer Marianne Achenbach read Proclamation Resolution No 2015-R-42 and Chairman Gerald B. Anderson presented Mr. Achenbach with a plaque. Chairman Anderson and the rest of the Board thanked Mr. Achenbach for his years of service and dedication to the Township.
