Palomino Farms Tennis Courts - Earlier this year, the Township finished a complete overall of the Tennis Courts at Palomino Park (by Barclay Elementary School). These courts were rebuilt from the ground up, including a new base, a new surface, new fencing, new netting, a new walkway and some drainage improvements. A grant from the United States Tennis Association helped pay for these improvements.

2015 Road Paving Program - Last night the Board awarded a contract to Doli Construction Corp. of Chalfont for the 2015 Road Paving Program. The following streets are scheduled to be milled, receive new asphalt, and have new handicapped ramps installed:

2015 WARRINGTON ROAD IMPROVEMENT SUMMARY

Bridle Lane (T-438) from Palomino Drive (T-426) to Carriage Way (T-442) a total length of .16 miles.

Stirrup Lane (T-439) from Palomino Drive (T-426) to Carriage Way (T-442) a total length of .18 miles.

Stallion Road (T-440) from Palomino Drive (T-426) to Carriage Way (T-442) a total length of .17 miles.

Saddle Drive (T-441) from Stallion Road (T-440) to Carriage Way (T-442) a total length of .11 miles.

Carriage Way (T-442) from Bridle Lane (T-438) to Palomino Drive (T-426) a total length of .43 miles.

A portion of Grand Boulevard (T-530) from Guinea Lane (T-383) westward approximately 850 feet.

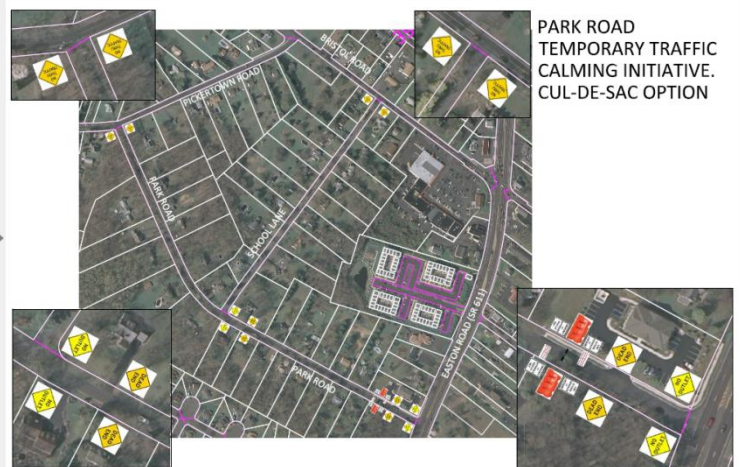

Public Hearing - A date will be scheduled for the continuation of the third public hearing on the Geerling Tract. The hearing is in regards to Sunlit Farms, also known as the Geerling Tract, located at 3091 Street Rd. Chairman Anderson is encouraging any interested citizens to come to the hearing and participate if they choose. Changes coming to traffic patterns at Park Rd. and School Lane - With overwhelming support from the residents of School Lane and Park Rd., the Board of Supervisors voted to close Park Rd and School Lane to thru traffic coming from or to Pickertown and Easton Roads. Excessive speeding by people using their neighborhood as a shortcut has made it dangerous to walk and play there according to the many residents that have been attending and speaking at recent meetings. Over the next few weeks, signs and barricades will be erected to warn and indicate the change in traffic patterns to motorists.
