CALL TO ORDER: Mr. Gaines called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

WORK SESSION ITEM:

- **2020 TOWNSHIP GOALS**

The Board of Supervisors and Township Manager discussed the following goals for Warrington Township:

- Ms. Schemm suggested adding the goals on the Board's agenda as an item to inform the public of periodic updates.
- Ms. Schemm met with the Director for Parks and Recreation and also Ms. Ross, Chair of Open Space and Land Preservation to obtain goals from this department. Also discussed was the Swim Club and to implement sustainability.
- Ms. Schemm suggested listing and tracking the goals in the township's newsletter, *The Link*.
- **Police Department:** Continue Police Community Outreach; re-introduce School Resources Officer and build the Police Department to its peak efficiency.

Finance Department: Increase the EIT to be used for Open Space funds; continue to research for the Mercantile tax; update website and social media; implement pay for performance; 2020 Census.

10 Year Master Plan: create a walkable township by connecting the east and west by trails and sidewalks; connect points of interest by trails and sidewalks; work with outside organizations and begin with Street, Bristol, County Line, Easton, Folly Lower State, Upper State, Pickertown Roads and Limekiln Pike.

Ambulance Corps: Discussion to add another ambulance to Station 129.

Manager's Office: create a monthly newsletter via the website called "E-Link". Residents will be notified via email introducing the first electronic newsletter.

Added to the February 11, 2020 Board of Supervisors agenda will be to consider the adoption of Goals for Warrington Township.
