I have exciting news to share with you. Following two successful trips to Washington, DC, honoring our World War II and Korea veterans, Bucks County will offer another trip on September 26, 2016. We are proudly calling this effort ***Bucks County Tour of Honor***.

The organization with which we were previously affiliated to operate earlier trips expressed a desire to concentrate more on its home area of Delaware County and South Jersey. Honor Flight Bucks County (as we had been known) preferred more, rather than less, emphasis on Bucks County veterans. Further, participation in our trips continues to grow larger. Our 2015 trip had significantly higher participation than in 2014. For 2016 we are pursuing an exclusive Bucks County identity, ensuring we have the focus and capacity to serve as many county veterans as possible.

At present we are actively planning for our 2016 trip which we expect to be extremely successful. Obviously branching out on our own poses increased challenges. As such we invite your continued involvement and support. We are committed to keeping you informed on our progress and will share ways in which you can participate with us to guarantee success of the undertaking.

We have served 360 veterans during our DC memorial visits the past two years, but there are many more who have yet to experience the opportunity. We plan to continue offering ***Bucks County Tour of Honor*** trips until such time as all veterans have been served who may have interest and are able to travel.
