

DO YOU KNOW... in 1956 President Eisenhower signed into law the Federal Aid Highway Act, a law that created a network road system across America? Legend has it that when General Eisenhower was fighting in World War II he recognized Europe's ability to mobilize armies and realized that America did not have such infrastructure, ergo Interstate Highways.

Out of such legislation came one of the most useful public safety visual aids, the uniform Interstate Highway exit signs. Have you noticed when driving south on Route 95 nearing Philadelphia that the exit number is displayed on top of the street names on the overhead sign? Did you see where the exit number was placed? If the exit number is pushed to the extreme right on the sign the exit is from the right lane. If the exit number is pushed to the extreme left on the sign the exit is from the left lane. Just recognizing the placement of the exit number could save your life if you have to cut across traffic to get off the highway.

DO YOU KNOW...the Township Supervisors leased the historic school house at the corner of Folly and County Line Roads to the Warrington Historic Society?
