

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-0-08**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WARRINGTON,  
BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-O-15  
REGARDING THE WARRINGTON  
TOWNSHIP CONDUCT REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Warrington Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, duly established regulations of fireworks within Warrington Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Warrington Township (“Board”) having received input and heard concern from residents, desires to further restrict the use of fireworks within the Township;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Warrington Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania that Ordinance 2018-O-15 is further amended to provide as follows:

Section 1. § 502 Use of Consumer Fireworks shall be amended by deleting subsection (b) (vi) and replacing it with the following:

vi. Consumer Fireworks on days other than the following holidays: New Year’s Eve, New Year’s Day, Chinese New Year, Memorial Day, and July 4<sup>th</sup>. On New Year’s Eve, fireworks may be used between the hours of 4 pm to 1 am and on all other holidays fireworks may be used between the hours of 4 pm and 10 pm.

Section 2. § 503 Penalties shall be amended by deleting the \$100 fine and replacing it with a \$600 fine.

Section 3. Repealer. This Ordinance hereby repeals any provision inconsistent with its provisions, to the extent of such inconsistency. All other provisions of Ordinance 2018-O-15, not inconsistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.


